TECH TRAINING CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

This technical training program is a socially innovative one year project geared towards adults and/or youth with diverse abilities to obtain introductory level training in one of the three technical streams. Participants will obtain introductory level occupational, employability skills training, and work experience training in one of the three listed technical streams:

-Fire Protection

-Underground Utility

-Low Voltage

Project start date: November 9th, 2020

Eligibility Requirements

- Self disclosed disability
- Be a youth between 19 – 30 years of age
- Have a reading level of 5 (or higher)
- Have Essential Skills Numeracy Level 4 (or higher)
- Referred by a WorkBC Centre with an Action Plan
- Have a Permanent Residence, or be a citizen of Canada
- Have established a claim for Employment Insurance (EI) benefits, or
- Have had an EI benefit period that ended within the previous 60 months; or
- Have earned more than \$2,000 in insurable earnings and paid employee EI premiums on those earnings in at least 5 of the last 10 years (Note: the 5 years do not have to be consecutive years), and;
- Have an Action Plan (AP) that identifies Project Based Labour Market Training as a reasonable goal to support their occupational goal
